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Taste of India Food Festival is a community wide event that will be held on August 5th, 2018 from 12:00 Noon to 10:00 pm. It is an exciting annual celebration of Indian Food & culture. Take part in cultural foods across various states of India, food demos, food competitions, cultural performances, art and more. It will be a special for Indo-Canadians and lovers of Indian culture from all over Ontario. Taste of India expects approximately 10,000 patrons in addition to the 140 volunteers and performers. Nathan Phillips Square 100 Queen St W, Toronto, ON M5H 2N2 has easy access to public transportation. Admission to the festival is free and there is ample parking available.

All vendors must comply with the following:

- All vending fees are final and therefore non-refundable.
- If your application is accepted, this form will become the contract for your participation at Taste of India. A copy of this agreement, counter-signed by the

festival and a receipt for your vendor booth fee will be mailed to you before the festival.

- Vendors are not allowed to park in undesignated parking areas on the roadway, or in front of any entrances and exits. Vendors are to unload goods at allocated areas and proceed to their vehicle in a designated parking lot.
- Vendors must provide containers to collect garbage generated from sales to and ensure that their area is restored to its original state, free of garbage. Garbage bags may be left on-site for pick-up. Failure to properly dispose of waste will ban the vendor from participating in subsequent Taste of India Festivals.
- Vendors must provide extra, clean containers and utensils for both preparation and serving of food.
- All vendors must conduct their activity within their allocated concession area.
- The sale or consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited. Any vendor found selling or consuming alcohol would be subject to Police action, including eviction from the Taste of India Festival.
- All GTA by-laws governing vending, parking, etc. must be obeyed.
- All beverages sold must be in cans or plastic glasses. No glass containers are allowed on grounds.
- Vendor coordinators will be on site to handle any vendor disputes or concerns. We will do our best to accommodate your needs. Please keep in mind, however, that our resources are limited and that we cannot always guarantee that we will be able to meet your needs.
- All food vendors are required to bring their cooking and cooling appliances, clean water for rinsing utensils, and an adequate amount of bleach for sanitizing utensils.
- All food vendors are required to correspond with the Public Health Department. Vendors will be periodically checked by the Public Health Department to ensure compliance with Safety Rules.
- Vendors are prohibited from providing their own music or sound system.
- Vendors will set-up between 5:30 am – 10:30 am. The retail and information vendors are located along the walkway between the shelter/stage and the kitchen/food vendors. Vendor spots are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis as per the payment. The final decision lies with the management of school of flavours.
- Vendors are responsible for providing their own meals.
- Theft-prevention is the responsibility of the individual vendor.

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
